

Where bids at the same level are received, the earliest received by the Auctioneer shall take precedent. Please read the rules on the reverse of the form.

Postage costs are kept to the minimum - so please bid freely and perhaps acquire that elusive item! Good luck with your bids.

Reference numbers used are those of Huggins & Baker 2007 or Higgins & Gage (H&G). Other catalogues where used will be stated. The following abbreviations are used: STO means stamped to order, NVI means no value indicated, CTO cancelled to order, FDI first day of issue, 'emb' means embossed, a '+' between values means a compound franking, (hrr) means hinge remains on rear.

Price stated for each lot is the Reserve Price

Photocopies are available from the auctioneer at a cost of 10p per b/w copy or 50p per colour copy. together with an sae. A limited number of scans can be sent if requested by email. Email bids accepted.

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



Payment for photocopies should be made by cheque (made payable to Neil Sargent) or by GB mint stamps with full gum. There is a limit of 10 photocopies per member for each auction.
- 2. There is no buyer's premium or other charge with this auction. Successful bidders will be asked to pay only the hammer price and the cost of postage and packing as appropriate, subject to a minimum of £1.10
