

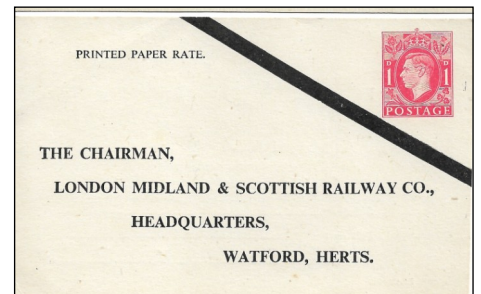
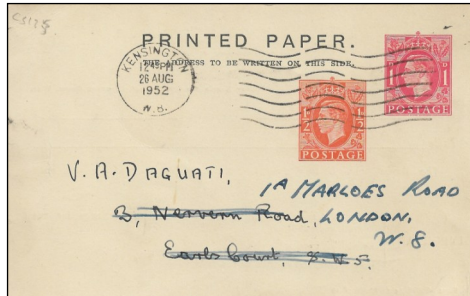

Please print your name & address clearly.** Lots will be purchased at one step above the next highest bid, subject to the reserve price quoted.. Where bids at the same level are received, the earliest received by the Auctioneer shall take precedent. Please read the rules on the reverse of the form.

This catalogue, whilst containing fewer lots than previous auctions, contains some very good quality and rarer items. It includes a large number of scarce KGV postcards both mint and used as well as KGV & KGV registered envelopes, QV postcards with Sloper cancels, quantity of compound QV envelopes and other goodies. 2. There is no buyer's premium or other charge with this auction. Successful bidders will be asked to pay only the hammer price and the cost of postage and packing as appropriate, subject to a minimum of £1.10
