Requests for photocopies should be made to the auctioneer, Neil Sargent, in plenty of time, and should be accompanied by the cost of the photocopies requested together with a large stamped addressed envelope or international reply coupons. Payment for photocopies should be made by cheque (made payable to Neil Sargent) or by GB mint stamps with full gum. There is a limit of 10 photocopies per member for each auction.
2. There is no buyer's premium or other charge with this auction. Successful bidders will be asked to pay only the hammer price and the cost of postage and packing as appropriate, subject to a minimum of $£ 1.10$
3. Please enter details of your bids on the front of this form. Please check your bids carefully, as it may be difficult to correct mistakes at a later date. The bidding form must be signed and dated, and submitted to the auctioneer by the closing date for postal bids given on the front of the auction catalogue.
