## ROOM \& POSTAL AUCTION Saturday 2nd October 2021

Welcome to our Society's room and postal auction to be held at our meeting at the Royal. Having come out of lockdown, hopefully the meeting will go ahead as normal - if not, then the auction will revert to being a postal auction only. It is great getting back to a degree of normality with the recent Midpex fair being excellent and reasonably well attended.
This auction is slightly different in having only just over 200 lots entered. This is in an effort to include some better quality items but also to include illustrations of all lots included. This is hoped to assist postal bidders with a better idea of the lots for sale and to improve the number of bidders for the auction. There is some excellent material included with a large number of stamped-to-order items with a rare used 6-die envelope to Canada; other QV STO items; some excellent KGV cards \& envelopes; registered envelopes, OHMS Factory lettersheet and a wide range of cut-outs and cut squares. QEII is represented by Stamford Mercury items; a fine sheet of 30 self-adhesive $1 / 2 p$ together with some bulk lots of airletters \& registered envelopes from the Channel Islands, Isle of Man and India.
Whilst I have taken every care in numbering the pictures, where there is any difference, the catalogue description takes precedent.
If you have any concerns or worries about bidding, please do not hesitate to contact me. Bids can be accepted by email as well as by post. Scans of lots can be sent electronically. Your bids remain confidential with the auctioneer bidding on your behalf. There is no 'buyers premium' or VAT to add. - so please bid freely and perhaps acquire that elusive item! The following abbreviations are used: STO means stamped to order, NVI means no value indicated, CTO cancelled to order, FDI first day of issue, 'emb' means embossed, a ' + ' between values means a compound franking, (hrr) means hinge remains on rear.

1. Photocopies of items in the sale will be available at a cost of 10 p black and white or 50 p colour per A4 sheet. Requests for photocopies should be made to the auctioneer, Neil Sargent, in plenty of time, and should be accompanied by the cost of the photocopies requested together with a large stamped addressed envelope or international reply coupons. Payment for photocopies should be made by cheque (made payable to Neil Sargent) or by GB mint stamps with full gum. There is a limit of 10 photocopies per member for each auction.
2. There is no buyer's premium or other charge with this auction. Successful bidders will be asked to pay only the hammer price and the cost of postage and packing as appropriate, subject to a minimum of $£ 1.10$
3. Please enter details of your bids on the front of this form. Please check your bids carefully, as it may be difficult to correct mistakes at a later date. The bidding form must be signed and dated, and submitted to the auctioneer by the closing date for postal bids given on the front of the auction catalogue.
