This auction contains a good selection of GB lots with some interesting examples including QV 2d + 2d reply card used both parts, some excellent QV STO envelopes, both mint \& used, good range of KEVII \& KGV used reply cards, There is an excellent rare KEVII Colour Standard and couple of rare Forces registered envelopes.
I am pleased to say we also have a good entry of non-GB lots including particularly strong Irish section with several items with scarce Price Bands. The catalogue starts with GB then Non-GB followed by a strong section of further GB in the Additional Lots.

Payment for photocopies should be made by cheque (made payable to Neil Sargent) or by GB mint stamps with full gum. There is a limit of 10 photocopies per member for each auction.
2. There is no buyer's premium or other charge with this auction. Successful bidders will be asked to pay only the hammer price and the cost of postage and packing as appropriate, subject to a minimum of £1.10
